

Health and Safety for Caregivers

Review Game Instructions

Set up:

There are 3 category cards and 9 question/point cards. To layout the game (tape or adhere to a blank wall or board), place the title cards in row then place the question/point cards below the title cards in a column (with the questions facing down and points in numerical order from top to bottom). Make sure you read through the table that has questions/answers to make sure the questions are placed under the correct category.

Game Layout Example:

Workers' Rights	Infection Prevention	Prevention of Musculoskeletal Injury
10 Points	10 Points	10 Points
20 Points	20 Points	20 Points
30 Points	30 Points	30 Points

How to play:

Split the group of trainees into two teams. Teams will take turns. One team will select a category and point value, then read the question on the back of the card that matches what they chose. For example a team may say, "Workers' Rights for 10 points," then pull that card off and read the question on the back. If the team answers correctly, then give them the card in order to keep track of their points (you may also create a score board to keep track of points). If the team answers incorrectly or doesn't have an answer, then the other team has the chance to answer and win the points. The team with the most points at the end of the game (when all questions have been chosen) wins.
