- Share whether you are seeking volunteer or paid positions as a Respite Care Provider.
- Share preferences, expertise, type and location(s) of work you are seeking.
- YOU control your own profile listing on the Registry.

Only those who complete the Respite Care Provider Training and earn a Certificate of Completion are eligible to be listed on the **New Mexico Respite Care Registry**.
